

FACILITY RENTALS

Need a venue for a personal event? Residents are eligible to reserve Park areas and Pool Pavilions for private functions. There is a \$25 fee for residents and a \$50 fee for non-residents. A \$25 deposit is required and refundable upon inspection. The Town of Rhinebeck has a carry-in, carry-out policy. The pavilions located in the playground are not available during Summer Camp hours.

* REFUNDS *

The Town of Rhinebeck does not issue refunds unless a program has been cancelled due to insufficient enrollment. Registrants assume full responsibility for any changes in their personal life that may affect their ability to participate. In rare cases, a participant may encounter an unforeseeable and unavoidable situation that they feel may warrant a refund or fees paid. These situations will be reviewed on an individual basis by the Rhinebeck Town Board. A processing fee of \$25 will be retained by the Town in all cases when refunds or partial refunds are granted.

RETURNED CHECKS

The Town of Rhinebeck incurs additional administrative costs and bank fees when checks are returned due to insufficient funds. The fee for all returned checks is \$30.

TOWN SWIM LESSONS



The Town of Rhinebeck Swim Lessons Program is an American Red Cross approved tiered program designed to provide students with a positive learning experience and teach children to swim and be safe in and around the water. Students will be evaluated on their first lesson to make certain they are in the appropriate level. Once all skills within a level are accomplished, children will be advanced. There are no minimum age requirements, but the child must be comfortable entering the water without a parent/guardian.

Level 1: Introduction to Water Skills. This helps students feel comfortable in the water.

Level 2: Fundamental Aquatic Skills. This gives students success with fundamental skills.

Level 3: Stroke Development. This builds on skills from Level 2 by providing guided practice.

Level 4: Stroke Improvement. This develops confidence in the strokes learned and improves other aquatic skills.

Level 5: Stroke Refinement. This provides further coordination and refinement of strokes.

*Please note: Levels 3-5 are typically offered in the deep end of the pool. Please consider this when signing your child up for lessons.

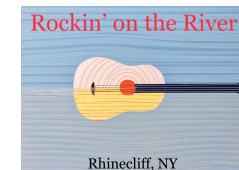
